## **City of Haskell RV Park Rules**

The City of Haskell's RV Park is for the temporary use of travelers and visitors to Haskell and the area. The first days stay will be free of charge and subsequent days will be charged at \$16.00 per day. Any stay over 15 days will require written approval of the City Administrator or the Director of Public Safety/Works and a signed rental agreement. Those individuals staying longer than 30 days will be assessed a long term rate of \$550.00 a month. Each space will be allowed one RV per area, should there be more than one RV each RV will be charged individually.

The following rules are established for the benefit of all users of the facilities:

1. Water can only be used for personal hygiene and drinking. No washing of vehicles or other outside uses are permitted.
2. Park in such a manner that no spaces are blocked.
3. Place all garbage in the provided dumpster.
4. Keep restroom and shower areas clean.
5. No feeding of stray animals of any kind.
6. All pets are to be kept on leashes and will be maintained within the tenant's space.
7. All animal waste must be collected and disposed of in garbage receptacles.
8. Any stay of two days or more within a seven (7) day period, whether consecutive or not will be considered as consecutive days and will be charged \$16.00 per day after the first day.
9. Tenants will be considerate of their fellow travelers and will not have excessive noise after 10:00 pm.

***If you fail to abide by the above rules you will be asked to leave the RV Park.***

Payment can be made at the drop box next to the RV park sign or at City Hall located at 301 South 1<sup>st</sup>; you can contact City Hall at (940)864-2333. If there are none emergency related issues after hours you may call the Sheriff's Office at (940)864-2345 and the Sheriff's dispatch will call the stand-by staff.
